Here is a general update on the latest:

Sessions:

- Call for Presentations due Jan 31
- Online submittal module created on APACA website for Hollywood and future conferences, based on San Jose's online forms.
- New session format concurrent "salon" and "inside the planner's studio" session rooms with shorter presentations by selected speakers in addition to standard sessions.

Registration Fees:

• Same as last year, with the exception of the Student Rate at \$200 instead of \$225. (Life member rate to match).

Mobile Workshop Fees:

- Increased to \$40 halfday, \$60 fullday
- Hollywood walking tours / walking sessions free
